INTRODUCTION

He communicated to you that you belong in a relationship with Him, and His plan for growing, developing and finding purpose is through being planted in Church community and fellowship.

The plan for taking God's Good News and truth to the world is through the Church, which is often referred to as a 'household.'

You will often hear Mosaic referred to as a 'house' because first and foremost, this is the term that Jesus used to refer to the Church in Luke 19:46. A SNAPSHOT ABOUT SERVING ...

IN THE BEGINNING

From the beginning of the Bible we see a beautiful picture of God creating humans to co-labour and serve God and His incredible creation.(Genesis 1-2)

MADE IN GOD'S IMAGE

We believe the Bible clearly shows us that we are made in God's image and created to reflect Him, which includes in service. CAN ANYONE SERVE AT CHURCH?

We love people who are eager to serve at Mosaic Church. We think serving is not only something that God demonstrates Himself and asks us to do, but it also enables people to build deeper relationships with one another and be integrated into the life of Mosaic Church. We have been given a considerable vision and so this requires a large group of people who are in community with one another, who's heart's are on God and who are prepared to share the load in and through serving one another, the house and the community.

For us, while enthusiasm is always important, serving does need to be attached to commitment to the house and those who say that Mosaic Church is their Spiritual home. This means that serving comes through becoming a covenant partner of Mosaic Church.

WHAT IS A COVENANT PARTNER?

A covenant partner is someone who has attended an exploring partnership lunch, and has decided that they would like to say that Mosaic Church is their spiritual home for the next season of their life. Partnership is for anyone who says 'I AM IN' and wants to be actively committed to making the vision and values of Mosaic Church a reality.

While we will always take into consideration someone's wishes, sometimes someone's area of interest may not be the best place for them, in terms of their gifts and talents and also due to the needs within a particular team. Due to this, this form is an expression of interest but does not necessarily mean that someone will always be able to serve in their initial chosen area.

Alongside this, safeguarding is of paramount importance, and so anyone wishing to work with children or areas where we have vulnerable adults, they will be required to go through the enhanced DBS checks with the police before being allowed to serve on certain teams. The outcomes of these checks would also factor into whether someone was able to serve on certain teams.

Once the response form has been received, the next step is that you will be invited for a conversation with that ministry leader and based on the outcomes of this conversation, a trial session or sessions will be arranged.

WEEKLY OR MONTHLY AREAS OF SERVICE

Prayer Ministry Team

Prayer ministry is part of Mosaic's pastoral care and is provided by a trained team. The approach is gentle, non-judgmental and we work in partnership with the Holy Spirit to bring release and healing.

Areas of support/skills needed/ requirements;

- Bible believing, Spirit filled Christian.
- Someone who has a pastoral heart for others.
- Willing to work as part of a prayer ministry team.
- Prepared to undertake several hours prayer ministry training.
- Have flexibility to be able to someone as and when someone may seek out this ministry.
- Prepared to have ongoing training.

Speaking Club

Let's talk together!

Ukrainian to English conversation classes. Classes are held with native speakers, in a relaxed atmosphere of a cozy cafe, in the Warwick Row Church Centre.

No homework and boring grammar but an interactive method of learning, for our Ukrainian friends to learn to speak freely.

Areas of support/skills needed;

- · Native English speaking
- Be prepared to describe English culture
- Gentle and encouraging nature
- Serve refreshments and clean down

City Nights

City Nights is our amazing young people ministry for ages 16-39. The heart of this ministry is to connect with and learn about young people across the city. Also, most importantly learn about the heavenly father in a way that is friendly and encouraging.

- On the 1st and 3rd Thursday, we have a service and social evening at Warwick Row Campus, CV1 1EX @7.30pm
- On the 2nd and 4th Thursday we have connect groups, split into two age groups:

Connect Group One - 16-20 yrs old Connect Group Two - 21-30 yrs old

Areas of support/skills needed;

- Hospitality/Serving
- · Welcome and Stewarding
- Tech/Media for the services
- · Set-up and Pack Down

Ignite

Ignite is our amazing Sunday morning time for 10-15 year olds. The morning is spent having fun, and digging into God's word, in order to deepen our young people's faith.

Areas of support/skills needed:

- Someone who is friendly and can connect with young people.
- Someone who is able to communicate a biblical idea in a creative and simple way to young people OR someone who can support a team leader do this.
- Someone who is prepared to invest in our young people on a monthly basis as part of a team.

IDY Youth Ministry

IDY is our fun filled, action packed youth ministry which occurs every Friday evening for 11-16 year olds.

Areas of support/skills needed;

- People who are friendly and feel comfortable chatting to young people.
- People who can give a Friday evening to invest in young people, and are able to work as a team.

WEEKLY OR MONTHLY AREAS OF SERVICE

• Mosaic Kids Ministry

Mosaic Kids Ministry is all about having fun and helping children find and explore faith from a young age(4-10 year olds). It runs every Sunday morning, alongside our Sunday morning meeting.

Areas of support/skills needed;

- Someone who has a passion for helping children grow in faith.
- Someone who can either lead or support a team leader unpack biblical truths with children of various ages.
- People who are prepared to be at Church early to help with set up, and pack down at the end of the morning session.
- Someone who is prepared to be on a team rota for once a month involvement with the ministry.

• Little Pieces

Little Pieces is our fun filled stay and play ministry for 1-4 year olds on a Friday morning; term time only 10-11.30am. It is the aim of the little pieces team to connect with families in the local area who want connection with others and a safe place for their children to explore and have fun!

Areas of support/skills needed;

- Available on a Friday morning during term time.
- Willing to help set up the equipment beforehand.
- Happy to be around children, and support with activities.
- Be prepared to welcome parents, as they connect with others in the group.

- Someone who is able to work as part of a team and feed into our Social Media manager.


Tech/Media Team

- High level Commitment with worship practice being 7.30pm on Monday evenings

Welcome and Stewarding

This ministry is a great way to demonstrate the love of God. It is a great opportunity to get to know others and fun can be had.

Psalm 84 v10 says 'I would rather be a doorkeeper in the house of my God than dwell in the tents of the wicked.'

To be reminded of Brother Lawrence who wrote 'Practicing the Presence of God' and who had people watch him washing up, as he was so full of the Holy Spirit and the presence of God was so tangible on him as he was serving.

There are currently 4 teams, working on a monthly rotation basis.

Areas of support/skills needed;

- · Work as part of a team
- · Enjoy meeting and talking with people
- · Serve tea and filter coffee
- Monitor stock levels
- · Steward the welcome and giving time
- Direct and manage people well
- · Enjoy a busy but enjoyable task
- Set-up and clean down

Kingdom Kitchen

Areas of support/skills needed,

- Cooks food hygiene certificate preferred but not essential
- Pot wash
- Front of house Welcome customers
- Waiting Tables & taking payments

Kingdom Kitchen food prep - 8.30am Open from 12-2pm every Monday (excluding Bank Holidays)

Foodbank

Mosaic Church hosts one of the busiest foodbanks across Coventry.

The purpose of the foodbank is to help supply food for those who have none, and to share the hope and truth of Jesus with the last, least and lost.

Areas of support/skills needed;

- Friendly disposition
- Reliable
- Flexibility
- Available on Wednesday and Friday morning, 11am-1pm

Afternoon Tea

Through a delectable afternoon tea, this ministry creates a welcoming and friendly environment for aged 60+ who may be looking for a place to connect with others.

Areas of support/skills include;

- Set up team, for arranging and organising the afternoon teas
- Willingness to connect with those that attend, in a caring and Jesus centered way.
- Pack down following afternoon tea, clearing the pots and room away.
- Every 3rd Monday each month 2pm

OTHER AREAS OF SERVICE

Events Team

In the life of Mosaic Church we have a variety of events that occur throughout the year, which need specific support. Events include new partners lunches; our Church conference; Christmas set up, Easter outreach....and much more! These occur at specific times of the year and when they do, they often need a larger than normal team to support. If this is something that you could help with, with some pre-warning of dates, we would love to hear from you.

Areas of support/skills needed/requirements;

- People who are confident at catering in the kitchen, or the food preparation for large groups of people.
- People who can serve food and/or serve others.
- People who are willing to be part of a set up or pack down team before or/and after an event.
- Seasonal Decoration team who are gifted in interior decorating.

Dinner Parties Hosts

Mosaic Church believes in the importance of creating community and breaking bread together on a regular basis. Due to this, dinner parties are something that happens once every 6 weeks, where, across the City parties are hosted so that Church family can gather together; get to know one another and grow together.

Areas of support/skills needed;

- People who are welcoming and hospitable, and enjoy cooking for others.
- A home that holds at least 8 people

Garden/Building Maintenance

We want to be known as people of excellence. This not only includes who we are and what we do, but also how we steward what we have. The Church have a number of sites that all require maintenance.

Areas of support/Skills needed;

- Willingness to offer professional trade services to the Church, to help us renovate and maintain the properties we have.
- Ability to brush, clean, plant and weed gardens at our properties.

These services would work in line with our buildings and facilities manager.
